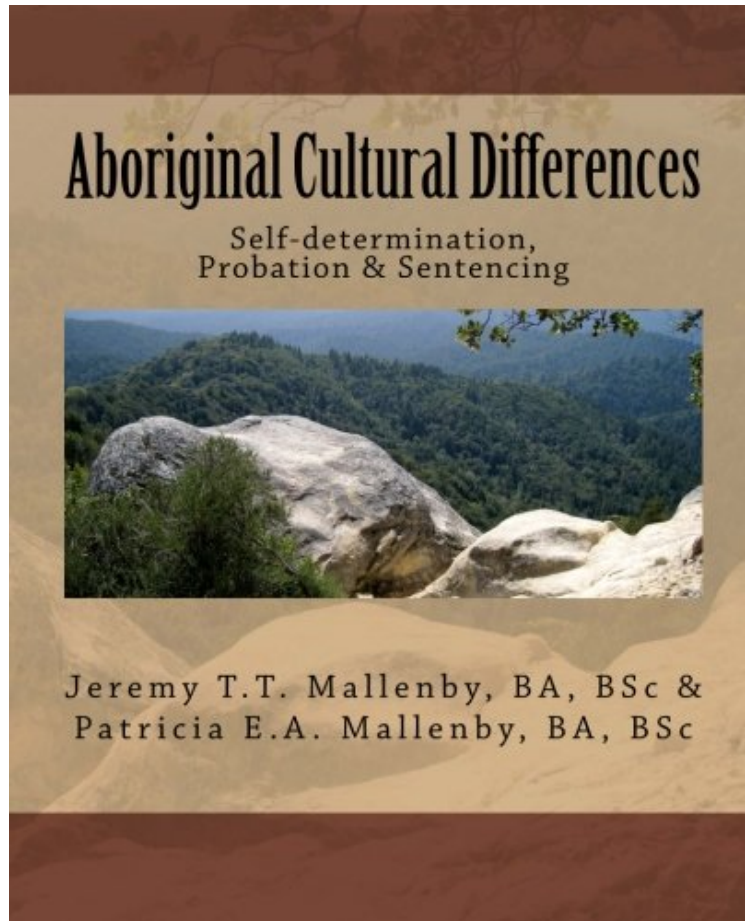

peace and order to the community without using imprisonment.
