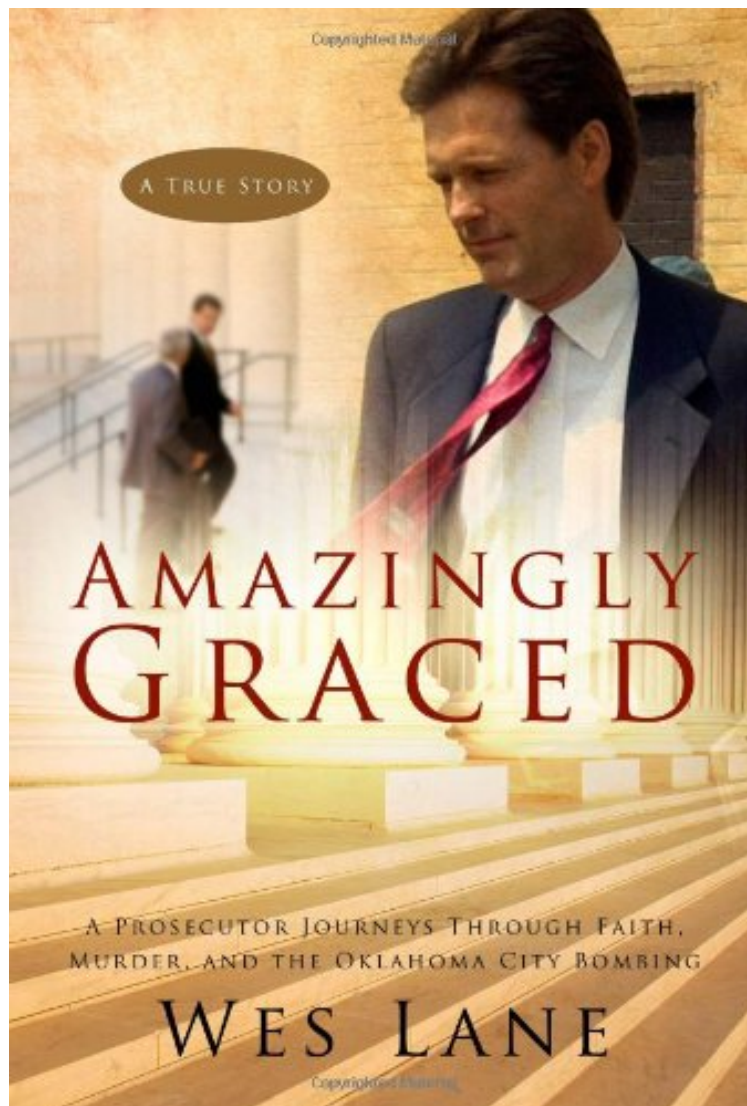

it might be your story as well. If you have been a "get along" Christian, but know you want to be in a deeper relation with God, this book will be of lasting importance to you. All the chapters are compelling, not just in the vivid scenarios the author paints, but in the personal and intimate aspects of his life which he shares so freely. For me, it is the final chapter which demands the greatest response. It is Sunday and I just now put it down and began to look around while I reflect on its message. It is a cold February in Oklahoma, but my eyes settle on a palm tree. I'm in Kuwait City and God is everywhere. The palm tree reminds me of the many wonderful things He created for my pleasure. And when I think about its unique beauty, I start thinking about how I will begin my prayer of praise and then, of course, realize that I've already started. My reflection on this book brings me to the point that there is no need to say to myself, "it's time to pray" and then later, time to finish with "amen". Wes Lane's story reminds me that prayer is not just checking in with God, it is an ever-present conversation. It isn't waking up in the morning with "Dear Lord" but rather, "Hey there Father!
