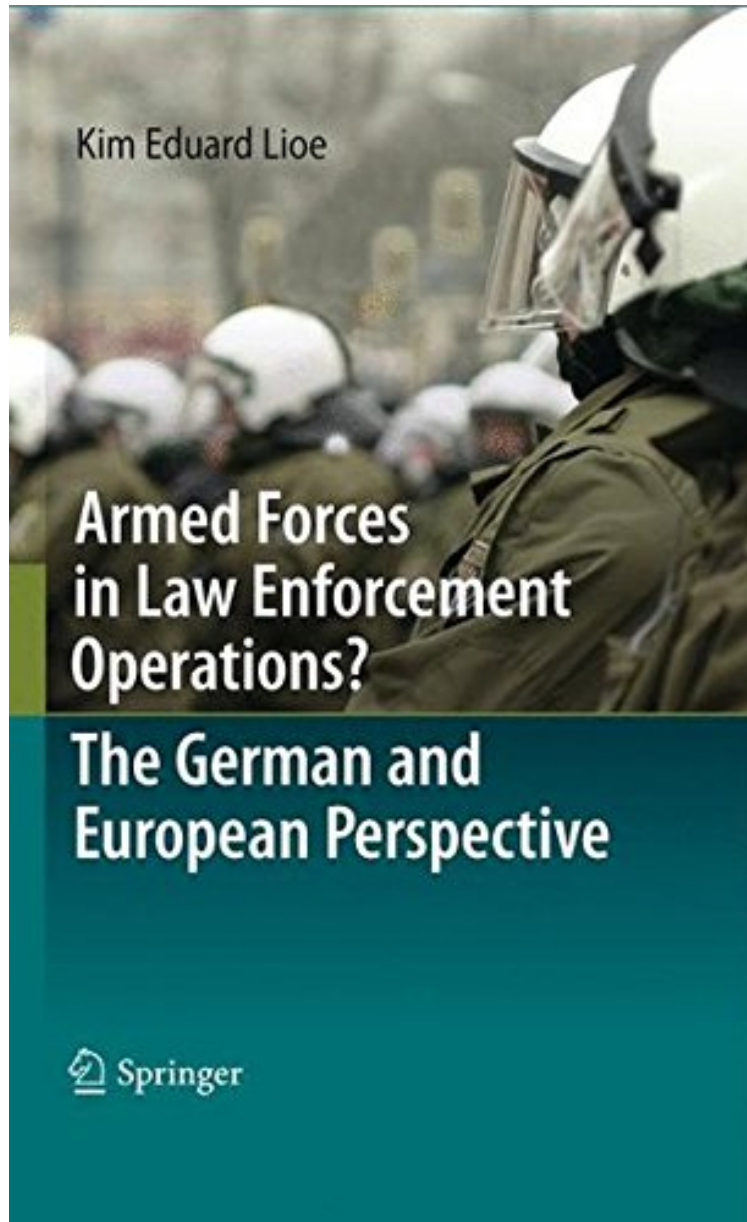

The only weaknesses was that the book was developed from a thesis/dissertation and as a result "failed to flow" in its reading and at points was very repetitive in the points it was trying to make. Another weakness was the original study was written from a German comparison so the discussion concerning gendarmes was no as detailed as it could have been because Germany doesn't have such an organization.
