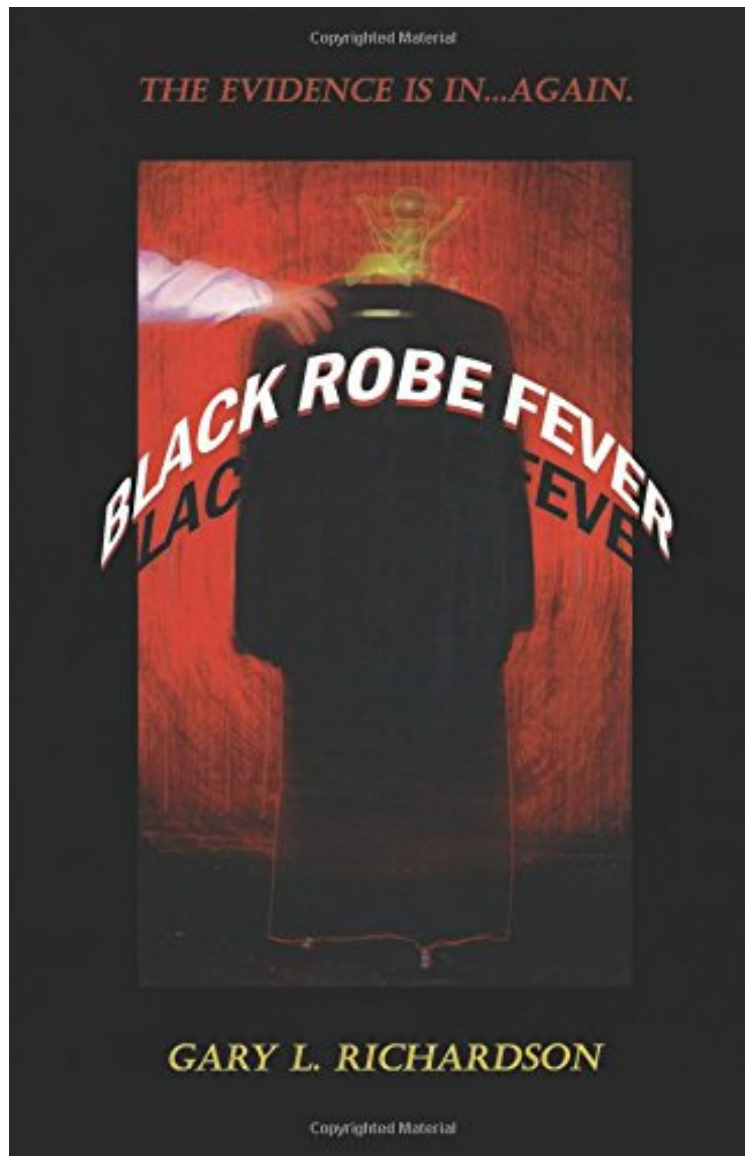

to varying degrees of what is often referred to as Black Robe Fever - a disease of cowards judges who rob citizens of the right to a fair trial and often intimidates attorneys into fear of standing up to them. As the author says, there is no course in law school that prepares an lawyer to deal with aberrant behaviors on the part of a judge, causing some so back down at the expense of their clients right to fair representation and trial. However, now comes this an eye opener must-read book for every one: whether a new or seasoned attorney or citizen who has been in the presence of a judge in action whose behavior ranged from questionable to alarming. Behavior which raised a red flag that something is not fair or right. That the judge appears to be a bully, appearing to side to siding with one of the two parties in a case, ridiculing a witness or attorney - biased when he or she is supposed to be impartial and patient in administering the law. One would think this is uncommon but it isn't, primarily because judges appointed or elected and not subject to as much oversight as the attorneys are. Over time, the behavior of these rouge judges tend to shred the very fabric of a judicial system. So what to do? How can court room justice prevail in the face of a bully judge? Richardson tells us about Black Robe Fever and his encounters with a variety of judges during his many years representing plaintiffs and defendants and how he learned along the way to deal with these judges as best as possible with integrity, patience and humility and not lose faith in the system.
