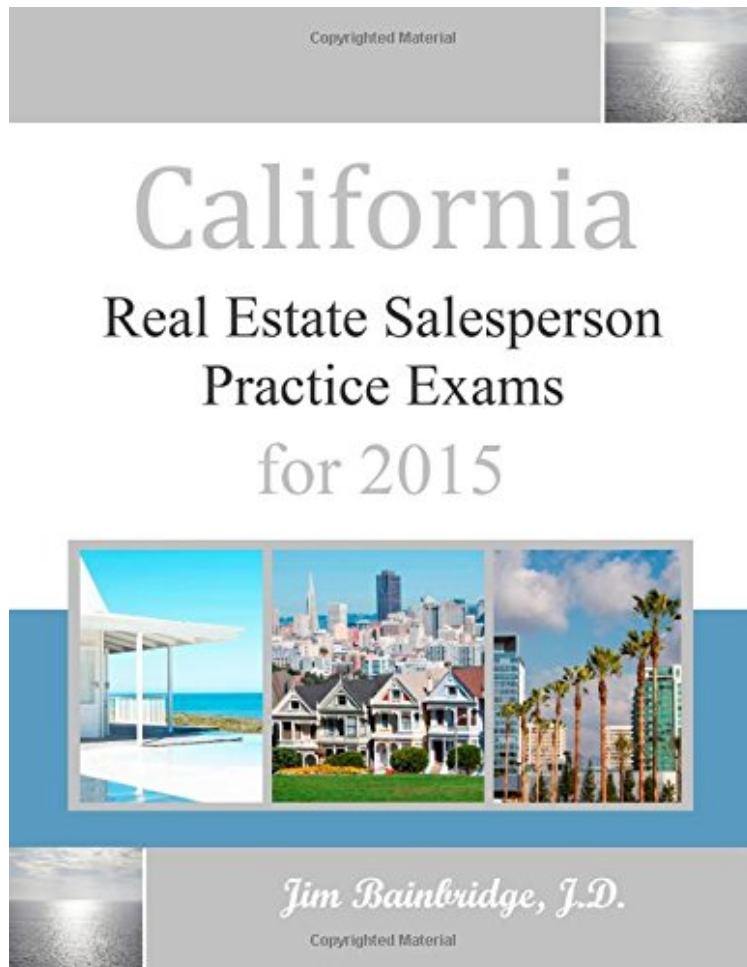

Also, it seems like the questions from test to test are repetitive and mainly focus on a couple of subjects as opposed to the full spectrum of Real Estate. Lastly, there are many grammatical errors and wording that makes the question and/or answer confusing to understand.
