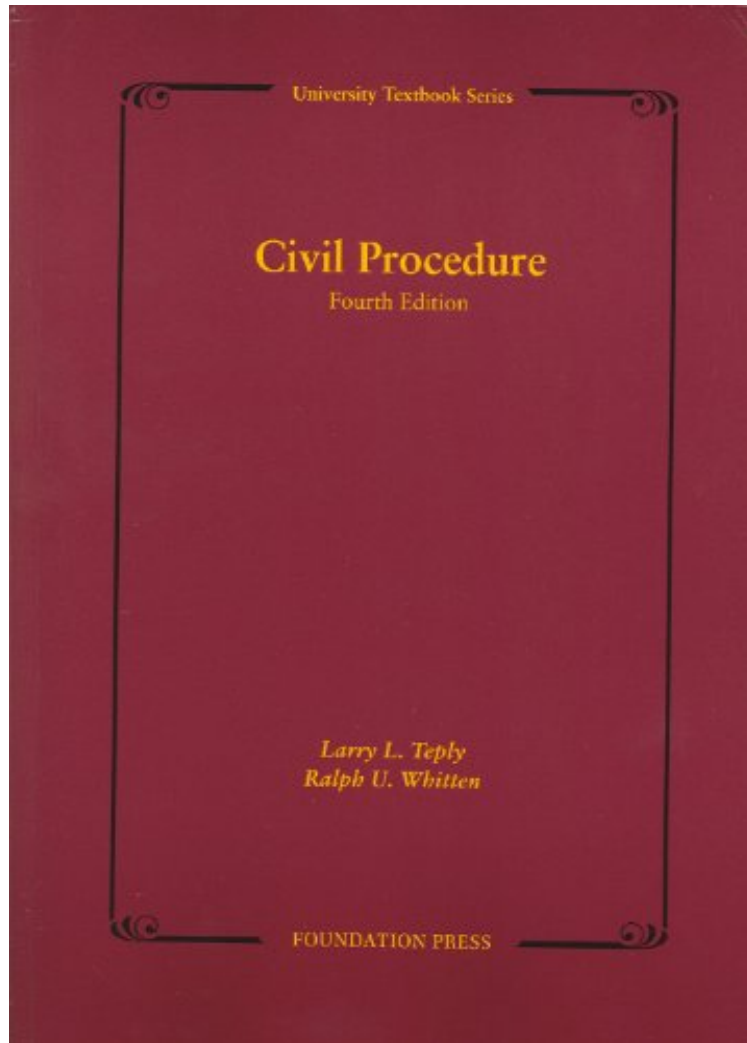

Instead of writing a concise book designed to equip a potential lawyer for the day to day uses of the Rules of Civil Procedure, Whitten wrote a tome, filled with obscure arguments about subjects that rarely come up.
