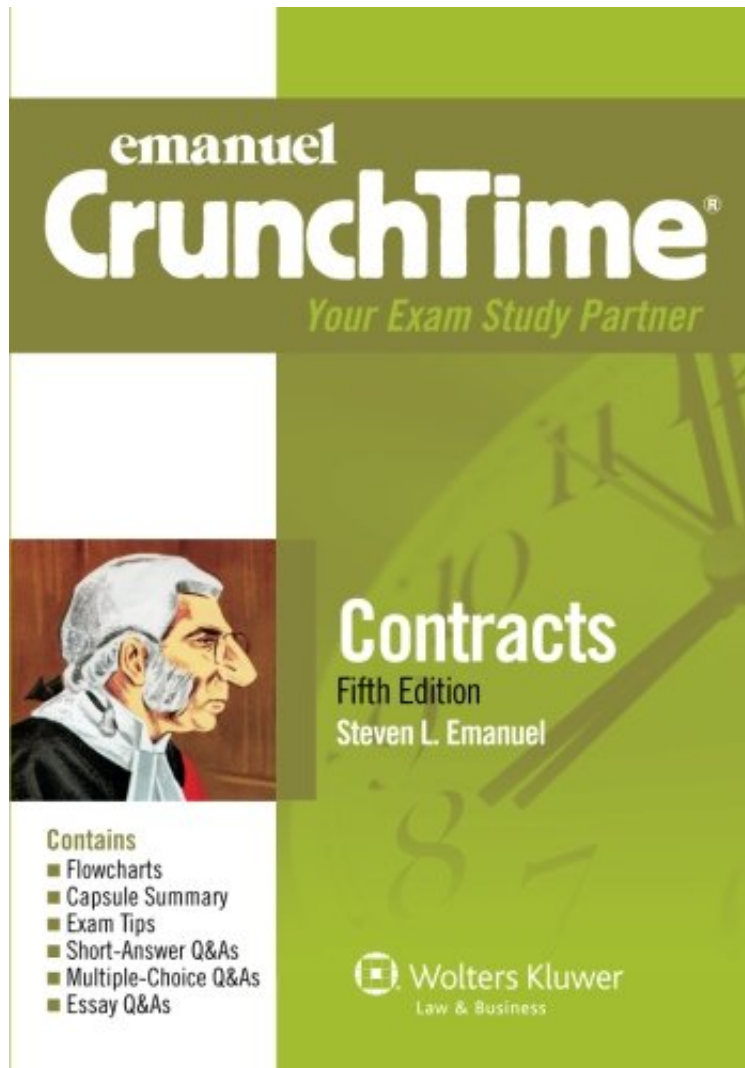

The thing with fact patterns in contracts is that, like torts, many issues are not easily spotted. There can be so many hidden issues that are easily overlooked, unlike subjects like, say, property. The things like, "just because your fact pattern says X, don't forget to mention the possibility of Y or Z happening." They might have been small points,
